Communication is a key to Human Development

Here are some ideas to help your baby or toddler develop communications skills:

I) Respond to your baby's gestures, looks and sounds. Be Openly Affectionate.

2) Talk to the child and listen to them.

- 3) Help children build on their language skills. Play with Your Baby.
- 4) Read Together.
- 5) Teach your child about non-verbal communication. Encourage them to Explore.
- 6) Respect and recognize your child's feelings.
- 7) Allow your child to develop a "feelings" vocabulary.
- 8) Narrate what you do as you go through y; our daily routines.
- 9) Encourage pretends play.
- 10) Make your requests clear, simple, and appropriate for your child's age and ability.
- II) Be a good role model.
